

IADC Rig Pass/PEC Orientation Training Course Outline

In both 8 hour classes students are presented basic safety awareness training on various topics. This orientation training is required by the MMS and satisfies API Recommended Practice T1. TRS has been approved by IADC to present the RIG PASS and is approved to present the equivalent PEC Basic Safety Awareness training. Students receive a IADC Rig Pass Card or PEC card (whichever the customer requires) upon successful completion. Note: that this orientation course will not satisfy the required compliance training (ie. Hazwoper).

Course Outline:

1. Introduction – training objectives; class rules.
2. General Safety – attitude principles, alcohol & drug policies, weapons & firearms policy, personal conduct, housekeeping, chain of command/communications, accident/incident reporting, driving safety (video).
3. PPE – head, face & eye, foot, hand, hearing, fall (slips, trips & fall protection video), respiratory protection, PFD, miscellaneous, display & demo of PPE.
4. Hazard Communication (video), Hazardous Materials Transportation, Waste Disposal & Minimization, Environmental Compliance, HAZWOPER.
5. Occupational Health – Employee responsibilities, specific health hazards (H₂S, NORM, benzene & toluene, sand, asbestos, acids & bases).
6. Specialized Work Procedures – general (Lockout/Tagout, confined space entry, hot work, other), LO/TO video.
7. Fire Safety – prevention, responsibilities.
8. Material handling – mechanical equipment, back safety video.
9. First Aid Treatment
10. Rig/Platform environment.
11. Emergency response.
12. Offshore safety awareness – general, video.
13. Water Survival – general video.
14. Marine Trash & Debris
15. Test, Completion Card Issuance.
